Senator Proposes \$107B Infrastructure Plan



Legislation proposed by [Sen. Deb Fischer, R-Neb.](#) would shift \$21.4 billion a year for the next five years from Customs and Border Patrol operations to the Highway Trust Fund. "Funding challenges and the burdensome federal regulatory approval process have delayed infrastructure projects across America for decades. It is time for a new approach" she says.
