
Project Details

- \$180 million contract
- Just over 3-year Schedule Started April 2021
- Reconstruction of the interchange between I-29 and I-480.
- Relocate 41st St interchange to 40th Street
- One-way frontage roadways provide access between I-29 and West Broadway.
- Removal of the interchange at 35th St.



ADAPTIVE SIGNAL CONTROL TECHNOLOGY

- Implemented due to variability:
 - Interstate traffic
 - Construction traffic
 - Event traffic
- Cycle Length / Splits / Offsets adjust every cycle based on demand
- Volume 🕇 Cycle/Split 🕇 Queue 🖊
- Volume 🖊 Cycle/Split 🖊 System 🖊 Delay
 - -All while maintaining coordination






